3.	<ul> <li>Consider if new information needs to be shared with the student or PSI instructor and administration staff.</li> <li>Send an email, or</li> <li>Phone, and</li> <li>Update HSPnet</li> <li>Consult with Professional Practice</li> </ul>	
	During the placement shift or learning activity	
4.	Reinforce and model compliance with all infection control procedures and precautions at every opportunity, including but not limited to, hand-washing guidelines, policies and protocols.	
5.	<ul> <li>Ask student about individual learning needs.</li> <li>Review PPE recommendations for suspected or confirmed COVID-19 patients if applicable.</li> <li>Demonstrate and coach correct PPE donning and doffing procedures.</li> </ul>	
6.	<ul> <li>If a student becomes symptomatic, arrange for them to leave the practice setting immediately.</li> <li>Guide the student to complete a BC COVID-19 Symptom Self-Assessment Tool, or</li> <li>Guide the student to self-refer to an Island Health Testing and Assessment Clinic https://medicalstaff.islandhealth.ca/testing-and-assessment-clinics</li> </ul>	
7.	Notify the PSI instructor of the symptoms through email or phone call	
	Prior to the end of the placement shift or learning activity
