2.	<ul> <li>Reduce the risk of transmission.</li> <li>Complete the BC COVID-19 Self-Assessment Tool prior to each shift.</li> <li>Follow the advice of your local public health authority.</li> <li>Practice physical (social) distancing http://www.bccdc.ca/health-info/diseases-conditions/covid- 19/prevention-risks/physical-distancing</li> <li>Perform excellent hand hygiene at all times https://intranet.viha.ca/departments/infection_prevention/Pages/hand-hygiene.aspx</li> <li>Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.</li> <li>Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash or cough/sneeze into your arm.</li> <li>Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces http://www.bccdc.ca/health-info/diseases- conditions/covid-19/prevention-risks/cleaning-and-disinfecting</li> </ul>				
3.	<ul> <li>If you are an existing Island Health employee and/or work in Long Term Care, discuss the approach to placement outside of the facility in which you work with your PSI instructor.</li> <li>The province has implemented a process to support workers to work in a single facility, instead of in multiple facilities. This is a complex process and may need to have an individualized approach to support your practice education experience.</li> </ul>

10.	<ul> <li>Review current infection control procedures and PPE guidelines with preceptor and/or PSI instructor.</li> <li>Demonstrate proper Donning and Doffing of PPE as needed.</li> <li>Seek guidance and coaching from staff members and PSI instructor.</li> </ul>			
11.	Consistently comply with all relevant guidelines, policies and protocols, including but not limited to, hand- washing.			
12.	Reinforce all infection control procedures and precautions at every opportunity with students and follow the <b>Practice Education Guidelines for BC – Communicable Disease Outbreaks (currently under provincial review)</b> - <u>http://hspcanada.net/docs/PEG/3_4_Communicable_Disease_Outbreaks.pdf</u>			
D	uring your placement shift or learning activity			
13.	Do not cross over between an outbreak unit and a non-outbreak unit. This includes lounges and washrooms dedicated to those personnel caring for patients on outbreak units.

15.	<ul> <li>If you become symptomatic at work, leave the practice setting immediately and notify:</li> <li>Island Health preceptor or supervisor;</li> <li>Placement site leader; and</li> <li>PSI faculty</li> </ul>			
16.	Conduct follow-up requirements if you develop symptoms.
